3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to barbers, barbering, and  
7 barber schools and colleges in Alaska;  
8 amending Ch. 68, SLA 1957; and providing for  
9 an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Sec. 1, Art. II, Ch. 68, SLA 1957 is amended to  
12 read as follows:

13 Section 1. BOARD; MEMBERSHIP. There is hereby created  
14 the Board of Barber Examiners to be composed of Five (5)  
15 members appointed by the Governor. Four [THE] members of the  
16 [FIRST] Board shall come from separate major senatorial  
17 districts. [A LIST OF RECOMMENDATIONS] The fifth member  
18 shall be appointed from the district having the largest  
19 number of practicing licensed barbers. [MADE BY PRACTICING  
20 BARBERS IN ALASKA, AND THEREAFTER FROM A LIST OF RECOMMEN-  
21 DATIONS BY LICENSED BARBERS IN ALASKA.] They shall serve  
22 at the pleasure of the Governor.

23 Sec. 2. Subsec. (f), Sec. 3, Art. II, Ch. 68, SLA 1957 is  
24 amended to read as follows:

25 (f) To delegate any of its powers of examining,  
26 [AND] inspection, and enforcement to a member or members of  
27 the Board. [COMMITTEE OF ITS MEMBERSHIP; PROVIDED, THAT NO  
28 SUCH COMMITTEE SHALL BE COMPOSED OF LESS THAN THREE MEMBERS;]  
29 It shall be the duty of the member or members to carry out

1 all such assignments by the Board in the judicial district  
2 in which the Board member resides.

3 Sec. 3. Sec. 3, Art. III, Ch. 68, SLA 1957 is amended to  
4 read as follows:

5 Section 3. EXAMINATION FEES [FEE]. Any person making  
6 application for examination must submit with his application  
7 an examination fee as follows:

8 Examination for barber license. . . . . \$25.00  
9 Examination for barber teacher license. . . \$75.00

10 [OF TWENTY-FIVE (25.00) DOLLARS. IF THE APPLICANT SUCCESS-  
11 FULLY PASSES SAID EXAMINATION, THE EXAMINATION FEE SHALL BE  
12 ACCEPTED AS FULL PAYMENT OF THE LICENSE FEE FOR THE FIRST  
13 YEAR OF PRACTICE.]

14 Sec. 4. Art. III, Ch. 68, SLA 1957 is amended by adding a  
15 new section 3A to read as follows:

16 Section 3A. LICENSE FEES. The fees for various licenses  
17 and renewals thereof under this Act shall be as follows:

18 Barber license. . . . .  
19 . . . . .initial fee \$10.00...renewal \$10.00  
20 Barber teacher license. . . . .  
21 . . . . .initial fee \$50.00...renewal \$50.00  
22 Barber school or college license. . . . .  
23 . . . . .initial fee \$150.00..renewal \$150.00

24 Sec. 5. Sec. 4, Art. III, Ch. 68, SLA 1957 is amended to  
25 read as follows:

26 Section 4. LICENSE. Licenses shall be issued by the  
27 Board to any applicant who passes the examination [,] for  
28 said license, and who possesses the other qualifications  
29 required by law. (1) All licenses and temporary permits

1 shall have a photograph of the licensee or permittee attached.

2 (2) Every licensee or permittee shall display his license or  
3 permit in a conspicuous place in his place of business. Shop  
4 owners, barber school or college operators or managers shall  
5 be responsible for the display of all licenses held by  
6 employees in their shops, schools or colleges. (3) A dupli-  
7 cate license or permit may be issued to a licensee or  
8 permittee upon proof that his original license has been lost  
9 or destroyed upon payment of \$1.00.

10 Sec. 6. Sec. 5, Art. III, Ch. 68, SLA 1957 is amended to read  
11 as follows:

12 Sec. 5. RENEWAL. Licenses issued by the Board shall be  
13 valid for a term of one year subject to annual renewal by  
14 issuance of a new license. If renewal fees are not paid  
15 before July 1 of each year, a penalty of \$2.00 shall be added  
16 to the renewal fee. Any license not renewed by September 1  
17 of each year shall lapse. A person who has allowed his  
18 license to lapse may have his lapsed license re-instated,  
19 provided that such license has not been lapsed for a period  
20 of more than five years and that he pays a sum which is  
21 twice the amount of the renewal fee. [A FEE OF TEN (\$10.00)  
22 DOLLARS SHALL ACCOMPANY EACH APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL.]

23 Sec. 7. Sec. 1, Art. IV, Ch. 68, SLA 1957 is amended to  
24 read as follows:

25 Sec. 1. FAILURE TO POSSESS LICENSE. Any person who  
26 engages in, or attempts to engage in, the practice of barber-  
27 ing or operates a barbers' school or college or teaches  
28 therein without first having obtained the proper [A] license  
29 is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall

1 be punished by a fine not to exceed Five Hundred (\$500.00)  
2 Dollars, or imprisonment in jail for a period not to exceed  
3 thirty (30) days, or both such fine and imprisonment.

4 Sec. 8. Art. V, Ch. 68, SLA 1957 is repealed and re-enacted  
5 to read as follows:

6 ARTICLE V

7 Barber School and Colleges

8 Section 1. REGULATION BY BOARD. The Board of Barber  
9 Examiners shall have the power and duty to provide for the  
10 conduct and supervision of barber schools and colleges in  
11 the State of Alaska. Regulations providing standards of  
12 sanitation and skill shall be adopted by the Board applicable  
13 to such schools and colleges and to teachers and instructors  
14 therein.

15 Section 2. LICENSE REQUIRED. No person shall engage  
16 in or attempt to engage in the operation of a barber school  
17 or college, or teach therein or attempt to teach therein,  
18 without a barber teacher license duly issued and certified  
19 by the Board of Barber Examiners as provided in this Act.

20 Section 3. APPLICATION. Any person wishing to engage  
21 in the operation of a barber school or college or to teach  
22 therein shall make application for examination and licensing  
23 to the Board by submitting the following: (1) evidence of  
24 his good moral character satisfactory to the Board; (2) a  
25 certificate of health from a physician; (3) a diploma from  
26 a nationally accredited barber school or college offering a  
27 course in barber science evidencing the applicant's qualifi-  
28 cations as a barber teacher; (4) such other information as  
29 may be required by regulations duly adopted by the Board.

1           Section 4. EXAMINATION. Every applicant for a barber  
2 teacher license must demonstrate to the Board that he has  
3 the ability to instruct barber students in all subjects  
4 necessary to qualify them as competent barbers by passing  
5 an examination in theory and practice.

6           Section 5. SCHOOL LICENSE. No barber school or college  
7 may operate without a license issued by the Board. Said  
8 license shall be issued when the Board determines that the  
9 school or college is properly staffed with licensed barbers  
10 and the premises and equipment are sufficient, sanitary,  
11 and proper.

12           Sec. 5. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage  
13 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
