5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN THE FIRST LEGISLATURE FIRST SESSION
6 ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

7 WHEREAS, the Sovereign State of Indiana has extended con-
8 gratulations and best wishes to the newly created Sovereign State
9 of Alaska; and

10 WHEREAS, the people of Alaska are grateful for their
11 heritage of freedom, a substantial portion of which is directly
12 attributable to the great State of Indiana, and

13 WHEREAS, the people of Alaska are deeply appreciative of
14 the expression of good will by the Sovereign State of Indiana;
15 and

16 WHEREAS, the Sovereign State of Indiana has produced many
17 native sons and daughters now citizens of the Sovereign State of
18 Alaska, one of whom is the Honorable and Distinguished Alaska
19 State Senator George B. McNabb Jr. who originally resided in the
20 town of Carthage in the State of Indiana; and

21 WHEREAS, the Honorable Senator George B. McNabb, Jr. is ably
22 contributing to the formation and development of democratic in-
23 stitutions of government in the Sovereign State of Alaska pred-
24 icated upon his heritage from the Sovereign State of Indiana;

26 first legislature of the State of Alaska by these presents accepts
27 with profound gratitude the congratulations and good will of the
