4 FIRST LEGISLATURE—FIRST SESSION

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN THE FIRST LEGISLATURE FIRST  
6 ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

7 WHEREAS, the Sovereign State of Washington has extended  
8 congratulations and best wishes to the newly created Sovereign  
9 State of Alaska, and to its Governor, William A. Egan;  
10 and

11 WHEREAS, the people of Alaska are grateful for their  
12 heritage of freedom, a substantial portion of which is directly  
13 attributable to the great State of Washington, and

14 WHEREAS, the people of Alaska are deeply appreciative of  
15 the expression of good will by the Sovereign State of Washing-  
16 ton; and

17 WHEREAS, the Sovereign State of Washington has produced  
18 many native sons and daughters now citizens of the Sovereign  
19 State of Alaska, among whom are the Honorable and Distinguished  
20 State Senators, Irwin L. Metcalf, originally of Hartline,  
21 Washington; and Senator Alfred Owen, originally of Seattle,  
22 Washington; and also the Honorable and Distinguished Alaska  
23 State Representatives, Warren A. Taylor, originally of Chehalis,  
24 Washington; Henry L. Haag, originally of Black Diamond, Wash-  
25 ington; Robert E. Sheldon, originally of Snohomish, Washington,  
26 Earl D. Hillstrand, originally of Seattle, Washington; Frank  
27 E. Cashel, originally of Seattle, Washington; and Peter M.  
28 Deveau, originally of Olympia, Washington; and

29 WHEREAS, said Senators and Representatives are ably con-

2 stitutions of government in the Sovereign State of Alaska  
3 predicated upon their heritage from the Sovereign State of  
4 Washington;

5 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this first session of  
6 the first legislature of the State of Alaska by these presents  
7 accepts with profound gratitude the congratulations and warm  
8 good will of the Sovereign State of Washington; and

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sovereign State of Alaska  
10 by these presents express its admiring and respectful gratitude  
11 to the Sovereign State of Washington for the native sons and  
12 daughters of that state who are presently distinguished  
13 citizens and leaders of the Sovereign State of Alaska and who  
14 are contributing their heritage of democratic government to  
15 the State of Alaska.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be  
17 sent to the Governor of the Sovereign State of Washington,  
18 both Houses of the Legislature of the Sovereign State of  
19 Washington, and to the Mayors of the cities above-named.
