2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIRST LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES IN THE FIRST  
6 LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

7 WHEREAS, the agricultural and mineral development of that  
8 area between Hope and Kenai, Alaska, along Cook Inlet, has been  
9 seriously curtailed because of the lack of adequate overland  
10 transportation in such area; and

11 WHEREAS, the completion of a road in this region would permit  
12 travel between Hope and Kenai at a considerable saving in miles  
13 and fuel over travel by the only existing route; and

14 WHEREAS, such road would further provide a means of evacuat-  
15 ing the residents of the populous Anchorage area in the event of  
16 a crisis or calamity;

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representa-  
18 tives of the State of Alaska in First Session assembled, the  
19 Senate concurring, that construction of said road is urged; and  
20 be it

21 FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be properly  
22 engrossed and thereafter transmitted to the Honorable William A.  
23 Egan, Governor of Alaska; the Honorable Hugh J. Wade, Acting  
24 Governor of Alaska; the Honorable Frank Metcalfe, Commissioner of  
25 Highways and Public Works; and the State Board of Highways and  
26 Public Works.
