2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIRST LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to requesting the Governor
6 to transmit a building and con-
7 struction program for juvenile cor-
8 rection and rehabilitation facilities.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE LEGISLATURE
10 OF THE STATE OF ALASKA IN FIRST SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE
11 CONCURRING:

12 WHEREAS, the juvenile problem in Alaska continues to be of
13 great concern to the people of Alaska and to the Legislature; and

14 WHEREAS, in recognition of this problem, the Legislature
15 authorized an appropriation in 1957 for the purpose of construct-
16 ing a juvenile institution to assist in the correction and re-
17 habilitaion of delinquent youths; and

18 WHEREAS, the appropriation has been found to be inadequate
19 to construct the necessary facilities; and

20 WHEREAS, the practice of financing necessary capital
21 facilities out of present state revenues is unequitable in that
22 the burden is imposed upon the present citizens notwithstanding
23 the fact that the facilities continue in use for many years, thus
24 benefiting future residents of Alaska; and

25 WHEREAS, it is common practice to undertake the construction
26 of capital facilities through the issuance of state bonds whereby
27 the cost of said facilities are spread over their estimated useful
28 life; and

29 WHEREAS, the First State Legislature by the enactment of this

1 concurrent resolution is manifesting an appreciation of the
2 planning and financing problems;

3 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives
4 of the State of Alaska in First Session assembled, the Senate
5 concurring, that the Governor of Alaska, in an expeditious manner
6 transmit to the Legislature a building and construction program
7 which will set forth an amount estimated to be necessary for the
8 immediate construction of juvenile correction and rehabilitation
9 facilities which will then enable the Legislature to undertake to
10 prepare legislation necessary for the authorization, ratification,
11 and financing for the construction of said facilities.
