2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 9

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIRST LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES IN THE FIRST
6 LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

7 WHEREAS, Section 35-2-181, ACLA 1949, as amended by Ch. 6,
8 SLA 1949 and Ch. 15, SLA 1951, is vague and ambiguous in its
9 attempt to regulate lobbyists or lobbying activities; and

10 WHEREAS, lobbyists registered under present laws often do
11 not comply with the law; and

12 WHEREAS, the people of the State of Alaska deserve to know
13 the amount of money and numbers of persons engaged in attempting
14 to influence legislation by means of lobbying activities;

15 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives
16 of the State of Alaska, the Senate concurring, that the Legisla-
17 tive Council be directed to undertake a comprehensive study of
18 methods to effectively regulate lobbying activities directed at
19 the Legislature or Legislators of Alaska; and

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council report
21 to the 1960 Session of Alaska's Legislature with proposed legis-
22 lation for regulation of lobbyists and lobbying; and

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that appropriations for use by the
24 Legislative Council of Alaska's Legislature specifically con-
25 template funds for the study directed by this resolution.
