2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 10

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIRST LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN THE FIRST LEGISLATURE FIRST SESSION  
6 ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

7 WHEREAS, the Sovereign State of Illinois has extended con-  
8 gratulations and best wishes to the newly created Sovereign State  
9 of Alaska; and

10 WHEREAS, the people of Alaska are grateful for their heritage  
11 of freedom, a substantial portion of which is directly attribut-  
12 able to the great State of Illinois; and

13 WHEREAS, the people of Alaska are deeply appreciative of the  
14 expression of good will by the Sovereign State of Illinois; and

15 WHEREAS, the Sovereign State of Illinois has produced many  
16 native sons and daughters now citizens of the Sovereign State of  
17 Alaska, one of whom is the Honorable and Distinguished Alaska  
18 State Representative J. Ray Roady, who originally resided in the  
19 city of Springfield in the State of Illinois; and

20 WHEREAS, the Honorable Representative J. Ray Roady is ably  
21 contributing to the formation and development of democratic insti-  
22 tutions of government in the Sovereign State of Alaska predicated  
23 upon his heritage from the Sovereign State of Illinois;

24 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this First Session of the  
25 First Legislature of the State of Alaska by these presents accepts  
26 with profound gratitude the congratulations and good will of the  
27 Sovereign State of Illinois; and

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sovereign State of Alaska by  
29 these presents express its gratitude to the Sovereign State of

1 Illinois for the native sons and daughters of that state who are  
2 presently distinguished citizens and leaders of the Sovereign  
3 State of Alaska and who are contributing their heritage of demo-  
4 cratic government to the State of Alaska; and

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be  
6 sent to the Honorable William G. Stratton; both Houses of the  
7 Legislature of the Sovereign State of Illinois; and to the Hon-  
8 orable Mayor of the city of Auburn, Illinois.
