HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 13  
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
FIRST LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES IN THE FIRST LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

WHEREAS, the workload and responsibilities of the First Legislature in First Session assembled have been particularly heavy; and

WHEREAS, these unprecedented demands on the time and energies of the members as they establish a state government have not yet allowed the full opportunity for preparation and introduction of bills within the limits of the Uniform Rules of the Senate and House of Representatives;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring, that the time limit on introduction of bills set forth in Rule 64 be changed to allow for the introduction of bills by individual members up to and including the fiftieth day and to allow for the receipt of bills in the other house up to and including the fifty-fifth day during this First Session of the First State Legislature.
