2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 14

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIRST LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF  
6 ALASKA IN THE FIRST LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE  
7 SENATE CONCURRING:

8 WHEREAS, the agricultural and commercial development of the  
9 Kenai Peninsula, and particularly the area between the Kenai and  
10 the Kasilof Rivers area has been seriously curtailed because of  
11 lack of adequate roads; and

12 WHEREAS, at the present time a fine road is being built from  
13 the main highway west about eight miles to near the mouth of the  
14 Kenai River, and as a result a great many homesteaders have moved  
15 into this area and settled; and

16 WHEREAS, if the above mentioned road were continued south  
17 along or near the shore of Cook Inlet a distance of about ten  
18 miles, through perfectly flat country, it would connect with  
19 the Kasilof River Road, and would open this area to homesteading,  
20 and would be of great value to the many resident fishermen who  
21 would use it in the summertime, allowing many of them to then  
22 live there the year around;

23 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State  
24 of Alaska in First Legislature, First Session Assembled, the  
25 Senate concurring, that immediate construction of this connecting  
26 road be urged; and be it

27 FURTHER RESOLVED. that copies of this resolution be properly  
28 engrossed and thereafter transmitted to the Honorable William A.  
29 Egan, Governor of Alaska; the Honorable Hugh J. Wade, Acting

1 Governor of Alaska; the Honorable Frank Metcalf, Commissioner of  
2 Highways and Public Works; the State Board of Highways and Public  
3 Works; and the Bureau of Public Roads.
