2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 15

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIRST LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to farm road construction at
6 Anchor Point on the Kenai Peninsula,
7 and more particularly to extending the
8 present farm road a few miles.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE FIRST LEGIS-
10 LATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION
11 ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

12 WHEREAS, the Anchor Point River area is a fine agriculture
13 and cattle raising area and is growing in population rapidly; and
14 WHEREAS, the farm road east of the highway and north of Anchor
15 River is rendering wonderful service to the people who live on
16 or near the present road; and

17 WHEREAS, many homesteaders have gone far beyond the said farm
18 road to homestead and are finding it very difficult to accomplish
19 much without a road, and to get their children out to the school;
20 and

21 WHEREAS, this particular area is proving to be a fine area in
22 which to raise cattle, and several homesteaders are at present
23 preparing to engage in such cattle raising but are finding it very
24 difficult to accomplish much without a road over which to move
25 their equipment;

26 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State
27 of Alaska in First Legislature, First Session Assembled, the Senate
28 concurring, that construction of the said short piece of road be
29 urged; and be it
