2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 16

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIRST LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES IN THE FIRST  
6 LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

7 WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Alaska may be called  
8 upon to appropriate funds for the construction and improvement of  
9 buildings necessary to properly carry on the affairs of the new  
10 State; and

11 WHEREAS, it is desirable that the people of the new State be  
12 given an opportunity to express their feelings on the matter;

13 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives  
14 of the State of Alaska, the Senate concurring, that the Legislative  
15 Council be directed to undertake a comprehensive study and to hold  
16 public hearings in an appropriate city within each of the major  
17 senatorial election districts regarding the best location for the  
18 permanent State capital of Alaska; and

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council be directed  
20 to report their findings in a report to the 1960 session of the  
21 State Legislature with such proposed legislation as may be necessary  
22 to effectuate their conclusions; and

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that appropriations for use by the  
24 Legislative Council specifically allot sufficient funds to carry  
25 out the intent of this Resolution.
