HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 22

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to permitting the taking of
dolly-vardeen trout at the mouth of
streams.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION
ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

WHEREAS, of late years there has been a serious decline in
our great salmon resource; and

WHEREAS, predators have been and are a great menace to the
propogation of the salmon; and

WHEREAS, the dolly-vardeen trout is truly one of the main
predators and is of a commercial value;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in First
Legislature, Second Session assembled, the Senate concurring, that
the Fish and Game Board and the Commissioner of Fish and Game be
requested to allow the taking of dolly-vardeen trout by net, or
any other means satisfactory to the Fish and Game Board and the
Commissioner of Fish and Game, at the very mouth of streams prior
to the annual early run of salmon.
