BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES IN FIRST LEGISLATURE,

9

SECOND SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

WHEREAS, the proposed election code intentionally omits a

11

system for pre-election voter registration;

12

WHEREAS, full integration of all election procedures should

13

await legislation on borough organization;

14

WHEREAS, the present formative condition of all of Alaska's

15

political organization does not permit a long range solution for

16

pre-registration;

17

WHEREAS, an anticipated increase in population will neces-

18

sitate more formal voter identification;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature of the State of Alaska in

20

First Legislature, Second Session assembled, that the Legislative

21

Council be directed to make a study of pre-election registration

22

with a view to making practical and applicable recommendations

23

for the State of Alaska, and submitting their findings and

24

recommendations not later than 10 days after the opening of the

25

1961 session of the Alaska State Legislature; and be it

26

FURTHER RESOLVED that appropriations for use by the Legisla-

27

tive Council of Alaska's Legislature specifically contemplate

28

funds for the study directed by this resolution.
