5 Relating to disapproving recommendation
6 no. 2 of the Local Boundary Commission.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION
8 ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

9 WHEREAS, the Constitution of the State of Alaska and Ch.
10 185, SLA 1959, provide that recommendations for boundary changes
11 be made to the legislature by the Local Boundary Commission during
12 the first 10 days of any regular session; and

13 WHEREAS, pursuant to this directive the Local Boundary Com-
14 mission has recommended certain local government boundary changes
15 to the second session of the first legislature; and

16 WHEREAS, the proposed boundary change-recommendation no. 2,
17 for the annexation to the City of Anchorage of the entire Fairview
18 Public Utility District as proposed by the Local Boundary Com-
19 mission does not meet with the approval of the legislature; and

20 WHEREAS, boundary change-recommendation no. 2 has not been
21 given adequate consideration; does not reflect the wishes of the
22 majority of people in the area to be annexed; deprives the in-
23 dividual of his freedom of choice and therefore is in direct
24 violation of every American's basic concept of the democratic
25 process; and

26 WHEREAS, this boundary change-recommendation no. 2 will,
27 unless disapproved by a majority of the members of each house,
28 become effective 45 days after presentation to the legislature
29 or at the end of the legislative session, whichever is earlier;
