

1 IN THE HOUSE BY MESSRS. HAMMOND, FRANZ AND DEVEAU  
2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 29  
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
4 FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION  
5 Relating to the construction of a  
6 road to span the Alaska Peninsula.  
7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES IN FIRST LEGISLATURE,  
8 SECOND SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:  
9 WHEREAS, an access road has been constructed by private  
10 enterprise from a bay north of Kanatak to a site approximately  
11 ten miles from Egegik on the shore of Bristol Bay, nearly spanning  
12 the Alaska Peninsula; and  
13 WHEREAS, the extension of this road to Egegik would completely  
14 span the Alaska Peninsula; and  
15 WHEREAS, the northern shore of the peninsula is now open to  
16 marine transportation for only part of the year, being ice bound  
17 for the other part; and  
18 WHEREAS, the southern shore of the peninsula is open the  
19 entire year, being ice free; and  
20 WHEREAS, a road from Egegik to the Pacific side of the  
21 peninsula would both open Bristol Bay to commerce for the entire  
22 year and cut the surface distance from Shelikof Strait to Bristol  
23 Bay by some 800 miles; and  
24 WHEREAS, the extension of the road to Egegik could be  
25 accomplished easily, a simple, rudimentary access road being all  
26 that is required; and  
27 WHEREAS, said road might well serve as an important link in  
28 the proposed ferry system, eventually tying the Alaska Peninsula  
29 with the Kodiak-Homer route;

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in First  
2 Legislature, Second Session assembled, the Senate concurring, that  
3 the Department of Public Works be urged to construct or contract  
4 for the construction of the additional few miles of road to  
5 Egegik.
