HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 31

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to historical sites  
and relics.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION  
ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

WHEREAS, Alaska has been the scene of many nationally and  
internationally historic events; and

WHEREAS, Alaska abounds in historical relics of bygone days--  
remnants of mining camps and mills, wrecks of sailing ships and  
early steamers, abandoned trams, coaches, cities, and so forth;  
and

WHEREAS, these historical sites and relics have both a  
cultural value as mementos of our past and a dollar value as  
tourist attractions;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in First  
Legislature, Second Session assembled, the Senate concurring, that  
the Department of Natural Resources, the division of tourism, and  
the Department of Public Works make a concerted effort to pre-  
serve, make accessible to the people, and provide suitable  
markers--bearing pertinent historical information--for the many  
historical sites and relics in Alaska.
