2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 33  
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
4 FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to a state tree, slogan,  
6 and motto.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION  
8 ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

9 WHEREAS, it has been brought to our attention that Alaska is  
10 without an official tree, slogan, and motto; and

11 WHEREAS, this state refuses to allow invidious comparisons  
12 to be made between it and other states which have already adopted  
13 official trees, slogans, and mottoes; and

14 WHEREAS, there are over two hundred thousand people in this  
15 state, and presumably, at least half of them have a different  
16 choice for a state tree, slogan, and motto;

17 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in First  
18 Legislature, Second Session assembled, the Senate concurring, that  
19 the Governor of Alaska conduct a contest of all the people to  
20 select a state tree, slogan, and motto; that he appoint a commis-  
21 sion of four members of the House of Representatives and four mem-  
22 bers of the Senate to jointly judge the numerous suggestions that  
23 will be received; that the commission select from them an official  
24 state tree, slogan, and motto; and that it submit its selections  
25 to the Second Legislature at its First Session in January 1961 for  
26 its approval and adoption.
