BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION

ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest for the state to acquire

10

with as little expense and with as little trouble as possible land

11

for the location of state airports; and

12

WHEREAS, once an airport has been planned for a certain area

13

it is only natural that persons other than state officials may

14

show a certain interest in lands in that location; and

15

WHEREAS, if the state is going to take certain lands for an

16

airport, it is not fair for the state to encourage settlers to

17

take such land only to give it up to the state;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in First

19

Legislature, Second Session assembled, the Senate concurring, that

20

immediately upon approving plans for the construction of a state

21

airport, the Department of Public Works do all in its power to

22

secure the lands necessary for the construction of that airport.
