2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 37

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES IN FIRST LEGISLA-
6 TURE, SECOND SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

7 WHEREAS, the Local Boundary Commission, pursuant to auth-
8 ority vested in it under provisions of Section 12, Article X,
9 Constitution of the State of Alaska as implemented by Ch. 185,
10 SLA 1959, has submitted a recommendation relating to a boundary
11 change which is stated on page 4, Part III, of its report to the
12 Legislature dated February 2, 1960, and which reads as follows:

13 "It is the recommendation of the Boundary Com-
14 mission that areas identified as numbers 2, 4, 5 and
15 6, be established as unorganized boroughs and that
16 the remaining areas be allowed to remain as 'unen-
17 closed areas' or areas which are neither organized
18 nor unorganized, and continue their present status
19 until future action is taken." and

20 WHEREAS, pursuant to provisions of Section 12, Article X,
21 Constitution of the State of Alaska, the Legislature has the
22 power to disapprove any proposed boundary change by the passage
23 of a resolution concurred in by a majority of the members of each
24 house;

25 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in First
26 Legislature, Second Session assembled, the Senate concurring,
27 that the Legislature do and hereby does disapprove of the re-
28 commended boundary change as cited in this resolution.
