HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 38
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the continuation and completion of the road survey between Eagle and Circle Hot Springs.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

WHEREAS, it has become an absolute necessity that a road be constructed between Eagle and Circle Hot Springs; and

WHEREAS, a survey has been started to prepare for the construction of this much needed road; and

WHEREAS, our recent history indicates that costs of road construction will continue to rise as time goes by; and

WHEREAS, this means that the sooner necessary roads are constructed the less it will cost to build them;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in First Legislature, Second Session assembled, the Senate concurring, that the survey for a road between Eagle and Circle Hot Springs be continued this year and completed as soon as possible so that the construction of the much needed road may be completed as soon as possible; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to the Governor, the Commissioner of Public Works, and the Regional Director of the Bureau of Public Roads.
