4 FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the repair and opening of  
6 the Steese Highway by May 1.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION  
8 ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

9 WHEREAS, the Steese Highway is badly in need of widening,  
10 improved bridges, brushing, and repair of frost damage; and

11 WHEREAS, these conditions existed last year, were not  
12 alleviated, and caused many persons to cancel trips over the  
13 highway and forced others to turn back for fear of damaging their  
14 automobiles; and

15 WHEREAS, this highway is necessary for the use of the people  
16 who live at Circle, Central, Circle Springs, and Miller House,  
17 and by tourists, sportsmen, and miners;

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in First  
19 Legislature, Second Session assembled, the Senate concurring that  
20 the Department of Public Works is directed and the Bureau of  
21 Public Roads requested to perform the necessary maintenance work  
22 on the Steese Highway to make it open for automobile traffic by  
23 May 1; and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to  
25 the governor, the commissioner of public works and the regional  
26 director of the Bureau of Public Roads.
