2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 39

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the repair and opening of
6 the Steese Highway by May 1.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION
8 ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

9 WHEREAS, the Steese Highway is badly in need of widening,
10 improved bridges, brushing, and repair of frost damage; and

11 WHEREAS, these conditions existed last year, were not
12 alleviated, and caused many persons to cancel trips over the high-
13 way and forced others to turn back for fear of damaging their
14 automobiles; and

15 WHEREAS, this highway is necessary for the use of the people
16 who live at Circle, Central, Circle Springs, and Miller House,
17 and by tourists, sportsmen, and miners;

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in First
19 Legislature, Second Session assembled, the Senate concurring that
20 the Department of Public Works and the Bureau of Public Roads are
21 requested to perform the necessary maintenance work on the Steese
22 Highway to make it open for automobile traffic by May 1; and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to
24 the governor, the commissioner of public works and the regional
25 director of the Bureau of Public Roads.
