HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 41  
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the bounty system of  
predator control.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION  
ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

WHEREAS, the bounty system of predator control in Alaska  
should be based on and related to the principles of sound game  
management; and

WHEREAS, a proper assessment of the existing bounty system  
is not readily available to the Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature has been and will undoubtedly  
continue to be confronted with proposals to abolish, alter or  
extend the bounty system;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in First  
Legislature, Second Session assembled, the Senate concurring  
that the Legislative Council be and hereby is directed to con-  
duct a study on the bounty system in Alaska and to make recommen-  
dations to the Second Legislature regarding the retention, alter-  
ation or expansion of the present system and the advisability of  
adopting a state-federal cooperative predator control program in  
conjunction with the existing bounty-predator control system.
