HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 44

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES IN FIRST LEGISLATURE,  
SECOND SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court of the State of Alaska has not  
provided for a deputy magistrate at Wasilla, Alaska; and

WHEREAS, there has been for over thirty years a United States  
Commissioner resident at Wasilla; and

WHEREAS, the work load during the last few years at the  
United States Commissioner's office at Wasilla has exceeded that  
of many other locations where deputy magistrates have been  
appointed; and

WHEREAS, the Wasilla recording district is one of the oldest  
recording districts in Alaska;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in First  
Legislature, Second Session assembled, the Senate concurring that  
the Supreme Court of Alaska be requested to appoint a deputy  
magistrate at Wasilla and retain the present boundaries of the  
Wasilla recording precinct intact.
