HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 51

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to continued planning for the
construction of the Bradley Lake
hydroelectric project.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION
ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

WHEREAS, electric power facilities in the lower Kenai area
are presently overloaded and even greater demands for electric
power are in sight; and

WHEREAS, economic forecasts for the Kenai indicate that it
would be eminently suitable for electroprocess industries, pro-
vided that sufficient power now potentially available is made
actually available; and

WHEREAS, private power companies have expressed complete
disinterest in constructing hydroelectric projects in this area;
and

WHEREAS, a preliminary study of the Bradley Lake hydroelectric
project indicates that it will have a minimum capacity of some
30,000 kilowatts;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in First Leg-
islature, Second Session assembled, the Senate concurring that
the construction of the Bradley Lake hydroelectric project is
essential for the economic growth of the lower Kenai and that the
Congressional delegation from Alaska should do all in its power
to further the planning for the construction of this project; and
