3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION
6 ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

7 WHEREAS, the subject of organized boroughs as units of local
8 government has occupied the attention of many citizens, the legis-
9 lature and agencies of the executive department during the pre-
10 ceding year; and

11 WHEREAS, it now appears that the first state legislature will
12 not create any organized boroughs but may provide for their forma-
13 tion by local action; and

14 WHEREAS, it is desirable that the citizens be encouraged to
15 form organized boroughs wherever it will be to the best interest
16 of the state; and

17 WHEREAS, the state has been furnishing a higher degree of
18 services to unorganized areas than to organized areas;

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in First
20 Legislature, Second Session assembled, the Senate concurring, that
21 the governor of the state be requested to re-examine the policy
22 of each of the principal departments of the state in relation to
23 public services presently available to the citizens of local areas
24 outside cities, school districts and public utility districts
25 and that such services be held to a minimum in those areas capable
26 of supporting such services as an organized borough.
