7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION  
8 ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

9 WHEREAS, an international conference on the limits of terri-  
10 torial waters is now in session at Geneva, Switzerland; and

11 WHEREAS, the deliberations and the decisions to be made at  
12 this conference are of vital concern to the State of Alaska in the  
13 protection and development of its invaluable fishery; and

14 WHEREAS, it would be of great value for the State of Alaska  
15 to have an observer and advisor at the Geneva conference to advise  
16 and assist the United States delegation thereat; and

17 WHEREAS, the American Section of the International North  
18 Pacific Fisheries Commission has arranged for the admission of an  
19 Alaskan observer at the conference should the State of Alaska care  
20 to send one;

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in First  
22 Legislature, Second Session assembled, the Senate concurring that  
23 the Governor be and hereby is authorized and requested to send a  
24 legal representative of the Alaska Department of Fish and Game to  
25 the Geneva conference on limits of territorial waters in order  
26 that the interests of the State of Alaska may be properly and ef-  
27 fectively represented and protected.
