10 Your Memorialist, the Legislature of the State of Alaska in
11 First Legislature, First Session assembled respectfully submits
12 that:

13 WHEREAS, since 1953 Alaska and the United States Fish and
14 Wildlife Service of the Department of the Interior have been co-
15 operating in support of a predator control program in Alaska; and

16 WHEREAS, this program has been very successful and has
17 proven mutually beneficial to Alaska and the nation in the protec-
18 tion of the fish and wildlife resources;

19 NOW THEREFORE, Your Memorialist, the Legislature of the
20 State of Alaska, expresses its appreciation on behalf of the
21 people of Alaska for the cooperation and support received from the
22 United States Fish and Wildlife Service in maintaining this pro-
23 gram, and respectfully requests that it be continued on the same
24 basis as in the past.
