7 SENATORS FROM ALASKA; AND THE HONORABLE RALPH J. RIVERS, REPRESENTATIVE FROM ALASKA:

9 Your Memorialist, the Legislature of the State of Alaska in  
10 First Legislature, First Session assembled respectfully submits  
11 that:

12 WHEREAS, the village of Kotlick, Alaska located at the mouth  
13 of the Yukon River has no local post office; and

14 WHEREAS, this lack of postal facilities forces some two  
15 hundred people to travel between twenty-six and thirty-two miles  
16 in order to receive mail; and

17 WHEREAS, the residents of Kotlick have tried for many years  
18 to have a post office established in the village, but have met  
19 with no success; and

20 WHEREAS, Kotlick is steadily growing and includes a Bureau of  
21 Indian Affairs school and other facilities;

22 NOW THEREFORE, Your Memorialist urges that all necessary  
23 action be taken by the federal government to establish a United  
24 States Post Office facility at Kotlick, Alaska.
