IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

TO THE HONORABLE FRED A. SEATON, SECRETARY OF THE INTERIOR; THE HONORABLE JEROME O. KILMARTIN, EXECUTIVE SECRETARY, BOARD ON GEOGRAPHIC NAMES; THE HONORABLE E. L. BARTLETT AND THE HONORABLE ERNEST GRUENING, SENATORS FROM ALASKA; AND THE HONORABLE RALPH J. RIVERS, REPRESENTATIVE FROM ALASKA:

Your Memorialist, the Legislature of the State of Alaska in First Legislature, Second Session assembled respectfully submits that:

WHEREAS, the people of Alaska shall be forever grateful to the late Senator Richard L. Neuberger for his gallant support of our struggle for statchood; and

WHEREAS, it is altogether fitting and proper that this nation and especially this state should express their gratitude to Senator Neuberger and commemorate his name;

NOW THEREFORE, Your Memorialist urges the federal government to name the mountain described on the attached memorandum, which is located near the eastern gateway to the State of Alaska, Mount Neuberger as a memorial to Senator Richard L. Neuberger.
