5 TO THE HONORABLE DWIGHT D. EISENHOWER, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED
6 STATES; THE HONORABLE ARTHUR SUMMERFIELD, POSTMASTER GENERAL OF
7 THE UNITED STATES; THE HONORABLE E. L. BARTLETT AND THE HONORABLE
8 ERNEST GRUENING, SENATORS FROM ALASKA; AND THE HONORABLE RALPH J.
9 RIVERS, REPRESENTATIVE FROM ALASKA:

10 Your Memorialist, the Legislature of the State of Alaska in
11 First Legislature, Second Session assembled, respectfully submits
12 that:

13 WHEREAS, the United States already had the highest postal
14 rates for first class mail of any industrialized nation in the
15 world; and

16 WHEREAS, the United States only recently increased its postal
17 rates to an unprecedented and unwarranted high mark; and

18 WHEREAS, there is no more reason for the Postal Service to be
19 self-supporting than there is for other specified branches and
20 bureaus of the federal government; and

21 WHEREAS, it is unthinkable that the federal government should
22 once again increase postal rates on first class mail, above the
23 present rates;

24 NOW THEREFORE, Your Memorialist urges that the federal govern-
25 ment refrain from increasing postal rates on first class mail and
26 that instead it seek ways to lower the operating expenses of the
27 Postal Service.
