HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 13

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of Alaska, the Senate jointly concurring:

That the Legislative Council prepare a draft for submission to the next session of the State Legislature proposing a uniform system in pamphlet form governing style, form and mechanics of legislative measures to be followed by both Houses of the Legislature.

That Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 2 adopted January 28, 1957 by the Legislature of the State of Oregon be followed as a guide in preparing the proposed uniform system which shall cover the kinds and purposes of legislative measures, formal parts of bills, enacting clauses and the body of bills, general rules as to form and style including punctuation, capitalization, abbreviations, official titles, grammar and sentence structure, spelling and like matters, preparation of bills for introduction, committee reports and amendments to bills, preparation of measures other than bills, legislative procedure on measures and similar subjects.
