HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 19

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the golden anniversary of
the Boy Scouts of America.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA IN FIRST
LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION ASSEMBLED:
