2 HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 1

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIRST LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES IN FIRST SESSION
6 ASSEMBLED:

7 WHEREAS, the Honorable William A. Egan, first Governor of
8 the State of Alaska, is presently under medical care in a
9 Seattle Hospital, and is therefore unable to be present for
10 the convening of the First Session of the Alaska State Legisla-
11 ture; and

12 WHEREAS, Governor Egan's early recovery is of prime concern
13 to all Alaskans, who have shared in his fight and joined in
14 their prayers for his recovery:

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That The House of Repre-
16 sentatives in First Session assembled does hereby express its
17 pride and faith in William A. "Bill" Egan for a display of
18 physical courage and devotion to duty equalled only by his
19 long-known political integrity and for his concern more for
20 State than for self during his time of extremity; and

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that expression also be made
22 of our great admiration for his wife, Neva, and his son
23 Dennis, who have in this difficult time displayed those quali-
24 ties of courage and strength traditionally associated with
25 Alaska.
