HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 7

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Relating to Alaskan participation  
in the World's Fair.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE LEGISLATURE  
OF THE STATE OF ALASKA IN FIRST SESSION ASSEMBLED:

WHEREAS, the State of Washington has undertaken the planning  
of a World's Fair to be held in the City of Seattle in 1961; and

WHEREAS, the First Legislature believes it to be in the best  
interests of the State of Alaska to display representative ex-  
hibits exemplifying the way of life and the products of Alaskans;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives  
of the State of Alaska that the Legislative Council be, and it is  
hereby directed to undertake a study of and make proposals and re-  
commendations concerning the best manner and means by which an  
Alaskan exhibit shall be presented at the said World's Fair, which  
report shall be submitted to the Legislature no later than  
February 1, 1960.
