house at Sterling on the Kenai Peninsula.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF

ALASKA IN THE FIRST LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION ASSEMBLED:

WHEREAS, the community of Sterling is on the Kenai Peninsula,

10

on the main highway, inland and about twenty-three miles from

11

Kenai, and at the junction of the Kenai and Moose Rivers; and

WHEREAS, the Sterling area is a fast-growing area, composed

13

of homesteaders who are building many fine farms, and it is also

14

in the center of activity of the oil operations, and is the center

15

of a fine fishing and hunting area; and

16

WHEREAS, Sterling has only a small school house built of logs

17

which was built by the homesteaders themselves at no cost to the

18

Territory; and

WHEREAS, the community has entirely outgrown the school house,

20

making it necessary to rent a trailer house and a small church to

21

take care of the pupils;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State

23

of Alaska in the First Legislature, First Session assembled, that

24

immediate steps be taken to see that a suitable state school build-

25

ing be built at Sterling for use in the next school year; and be
