HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 27

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF ALASKA IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION ASSEMBLED:
