HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 31

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the construction of a  
state office building at Kenai,  
Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION  
ASSEMBLED:

WHEREAS, a necessity has developed for a state office build-  
ing of modest size at Kenai; and

WHEREAS, the building is needed and could be used by the  
Department of Natural Resources for land, agriculture, and oil  
and gas management; by the Department of Public Safety as an  
office of the State Police; by the judiciary as a magistrate's  
court; and by the Department of Health and Welfare as a local  
office for its very important functions; and

WHEREAS, the need for the local office is great for each of  
the above listed agencies, the cost of the building will be modest,  
and the Civic League of Kenai will donate land to the state for  
the building in a central location in Kenai;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in First  
Legislature, Second Session assembled, that a state office build-  
ing be constructed in Kenai as soon as is possible; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be directed  
to the Governor and the Commissioner of Public Works.
