BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION

ASSEMBLED:

WHEREAS, there is no highway between North Kenai and Hope on

10

the Kenai Peninsula, and yet such a highway is both a logical

11

necessity and a rational project; and

WHEREAS, the construction of such a highway will be a boon to

13

industrial development, especially in oil and gas, will serve as

14

an evacuation route from the congested Anchorage area, and assist

15

and facilitate the distribution of oil and gas from the Kenai; and

16

WHEREAS, the construction of such a highway will open new

17

lands to homesteaders and purchasers, provide access to fishing

18

sites and stimulate the fishing industry; and

19

WHEREAS, the lack of such a highway prevents many children

20

from attending school for want of transportation and forces

21

travelers to use present routes which pass through dangerous slide

22

areas at Portage and Moose Pass;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in First Leg-

24

islature, Second Session assembled that the Department of Public

25

Works undertake a study for the construction of a highway between

26

North Kenai and Hope; and be it

27

FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution be directed

28

to the Governor and to the Commissioner of Public Works.
