HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 37

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the creation of a
Vocational Education Executive
Committee.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE IN FIRST LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION
ASSEMBLED:

WHEREAS, it becomes increasingly apparent that there is a
real need for additional vocational education in the public school
system; and

WHEREAS, the federal government and several private founda-
tions have expressed an interest in the furtherance of vocational
education; and

WHEREAS, it is up to the state to investigate the possi-
bility of procuring grants-in-aid for the furtherance of vocation-
al education in this state;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives in First
Legislature, Second Session assembled, that a Vocational Education
Executive Committee be formed to be composed of the secretary of
state, as chairman, a member of the staff of the Department of
Education, a faculty member of the University of Alaska, a member
of the legislature or from the state at large, and a member of
the educational staff of the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that this committee determine the need, de-
sirability, feasibility, cost, benefits, and availability of grants
for vocational education from sources both public and private.
