A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to proceedings for the recall of municipal officials; amending Ch. 90, SLA 1949, as amended by Ch. 126, SLA 1955; and setting an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 1, Ch. 90, SLA 1949, as amended by Sec. 1, Ch. 126, SLA 1955, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 1. Officials Subject to Recall. Every Municipal official elected for a term of office for more than one year is subject, as herein provided, to recall for malfeasance, misfeasance, or nonfeasance in office by the voters of the municipality in which elected; provided, however, no such official shall be subject to a recall until he has served at least three ~~SIX~~ months of his term of office.

Sec. 2. Sec. 4 of Ch. 90, SLA 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 4. When Recall Elections May be Held. The district judge shall within ten days after receipt of a recall petition, complying with the provisions of this Act, cause a recall election to be held by notifying the municipal clerk to hold such election forthwith ~~HOWEVER, ANY RECALL ELECTION MUST BE HELD AT LEAST SIXTY DAYS PRIOR TO THE NEXT GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION~~. The municipal ordinance governing special elections shall govern the recall election and all

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expenses of such election shall be paid by the municipality.

Sec. 3. This Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such approval.
