For an Act entitled: "An Act directing the Legislative Council

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. AUTHORIZATION. The Legislative Council is  
hereby directed to conduct a study and prepare appropriate  
legislation designed to establish an overall judicial system  
for the State of Alaska. The study shall include a review of  
all facets of the Judicial branch of the State government,  
including a comprehensive judicial code, the physical facilities  
needed, and the initial capital outlay and annual operating costs  
anticipated. The study and accompanying legislation shall be  
completed and presented to this Legislature within 90 days from  
the day this Act becomes law.

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act shall take effect  
immediately upon its passage and approval, or upon its becoming  
law without such approval.
