IN THE SENATE BY SENATORS PERATROVICH AND SMITH  
SENATE BILL NO. 4  
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
FIRST LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION  
A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to prohibiting fish traps on lands owned by the State of Alaska; providing for restrictive covenants in the sale or lease of such lands; defining violations; prescribing penalties; repealing Ch. 154, SLA 1955; and setting an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to erect, moor, or maintain floating, pile driven, or hand driven fish traps, as that term is commonly known, on or over any lands or tidelands owned or hereafter acquired by the State of Alaska.

Sec. 2. The lease or sale of any such State lands or tidelands shall contain a restrictive covenant in keeping with the intent of this Act.

Sec. 3. A violation of this Act shall be a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by imprisonment not to exceed six months or by fine not to exceed \$1,000.00 or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Sec. 4. Ch. 154, SLA 1955 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 5. This Act shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such approval.
