6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to prohibiting fish
7 traps on lands owned by the State of
8 Alaska; providing for restrictive
9 covenants in the sale or lease of
10 such lands; defining violations;
11 prescribing penalties; repealing Ch. 154,
12 SLA 1955; and providing an effective date."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

14 Section 1. It shall be unlawful to erect, moor, or maintain
15 fish traps, including but not limited to floating pile driven
16 or hand driven fish traps, on or over any lands or tidelands
17 owned or hereafter acquired by the State of Alaska. Nothing in
18 this section shall prevent the maintenance, use or operation of
19 small, hand-driven fish traps of the type ordinarily used on
20 rivers of Alaska which are otherwise legally maintained and
21 operated in or above the mouth of any stream or river in Alaska.

22 Sec. 2. The lease or sale of any such State lands or
23 tidelands shall contain a restrictive covenant in keeping with
24 the intent of this Act.

25 Sec. 3. A violation of this Act shall be a misdemeanor
26 and shall be punishable by imprisonment not to exceed six months
27 or by fine not to exceed \$1,000.00 or by both such fine and
28 imprisonment.

29 Sec. 4. Ch. 154, SLA 1955 is hereby repealed.

1 Sec. 5. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its
2 passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such
3 approval.
