6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the citizenship of
7 State employees; amending Sec. 11-1-4,
8 ACLA 1949 as amended by Ch. 82, SLA 1951."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. Sec. 11-1-4, ACLA 1949 as amended by Ch. 82,
11 SLA 1951, is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 11-1-4. EMPLOYMENT OF PERSONS NOT CITIZENS PROHIBITED.

13 It shall be unlawful for the State ~~TERRITORY~~ of Alaska,
14 or any municipality in the State ~~TERRITORY~~ to employ
15 at any rate of compensation as officer, agent, or servant,
16 any person who is not a citizen of the United States, except
17 that the provisions of this Act shall not apply to doctors,
18 dentist, public health nurses, ~~AND~~ technicians employed
19 by the Alaska Department of Health, teachers, librarians
20 and such other professional persons as are deemed essential
21 to the State or municipal service, provided, however, that
22 such persons shall have received their first papers, and
23 shall actively pursue such application for citizenship,
24 and shall have, before employment, taken and submitted to
25 the oath provided for in Chapter 113, SLA 1949 known as
26 the non-Communist oath ~~[.]~~ and provided further that in
27 no event shall this Act apply to teachers, librarians or
28 other professional persons temporarily employed or retained
29 under a foreign exchange program.
