6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the citizenship of State  
7 employees; amending Sec. 11-1-4, ACLA 1949,  
8 as amended by Ch. 82, SLA 1951."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. Sec. 11-1-4, ACLA 1949, as amended by Ch. 82,  
11 SLA 1951, is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 11-1-4. EMPLOYMENT OF PERSONS NOT CITIZENS PROHIBITED.  
13 It shall be unlawful for the State TERRITORY of Alaska, or  
14 any municipality in the State TERRITORY to employ at any  
15 rate of compensation as officer, agent, or servant, any per-  
16 son who is not a citizen of the United States, except that  
17 the provisions of this Act shall not apply to doctors, den-  
18 tists, public health nurses, and technicians employed by the  
19 Alaska Department of Health, provided, however, that such  
20 persons shall have received their first papers, and shall  
21 actively pursue such application for citizenship, and shall  
22 have, before employment, taken and submitted to the oath pro-  
23 vided for in Chapter 113, SLA 1949 known as the non-Communist  
24 oath [.], and provided further that in no event shall this  
25 Act apply to teachers, librarians or other professional  
26 persons temporarily employed or retained under a foreign  
27 exchange program.
