6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the citizenship of State  
7 employees; amending Sec. 11-1-4, ACLA 1949,  
8 as amended by Ch. 82, SLA 1951, and provid-  
9 ing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Sec. 11-1-4, ACLA 1949, as amended by Ch. 82,  
12 SLA 1951, is hereby amended to read as follows:

13 11-1-4. EMPLOYMENT OF PERSONS NOT CITIZENS PROHIBITED.

14 It shall be unlawful for the State ~~TERRITORY~~ of Alaska, or  
15 any municipality in the State ~~TERRITORY~~ to employ at any  
16 rate of compensation as officer, agent, or servant, any per-  
17 son who is not a citizen of the United States, except that  
18 the provisions of this Act shall not apply to doctors, den-  
19 tists, public health nurses, and technicians employed by the  
20 Alaska Department of Health, or to biologists or other tech-  
21 nicians employed by the Alaska Department of Fish and Game,  
22 provided, however, that such persons shall have ~~RECEIVED~~  
23 THEIR FIRST PAPERS, 7 filed their declaration of intention,  
24 and shall actively pursue such application for citizenship,  
25 and shall have, before employment, taken and submitted to the  
26 oath provided for in Chapter 113, SLA 1949 known as the non-  
27 Communist oath 7, and provided further that in no event  
28 shall this Act apply to teachers, librarians or other  
29 professional persons temporarily employed or retained under

a foreign exchange program.

Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such approval.
