6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the impounding of dogs  
7 threatening the peace, persons or property  
8 of a community; providing for the enforce-  
9 ment thereof; repealing Ch. 114, SLA 1951;  
10 and declaring an effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. Any dog running at large, or in a pack or  
13 threatening the peace, persons or property of a community in any  
14 way shall be impounded for a period of five days. If within that  
15 five day period, the owner of said impounded dog does not claim  
16 his animal and pay a dog-catching fee of \$10.00 plus an impounding  
17 cost of \$6.00 for each day the dog is impounded, the animal shall  
18 be destroyed.

19 Sec. 2. Incorporated municipalities, public utility dis-  
20 tricts, incorporated villages and organized boroughs are hereby  
21 authorized independently and in agreement with the State of Alaska,  
22 to enforce the provisions of this Act in any five-mile area  
23 adjacent to but not included in the actual boundary of said local  
24 political subdivision.

25 Sec. 3. Ch. 114, SLA 1951 is hereby repealed.

26 Sec. 4. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its  
27 passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such  
28 approval.
