5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the impounding of dogs  
7 threatening the peace, persons or property  
8 in or near political subdivisions of the  
9 state; providing for the enforcement there-  
10 of; repealing Ch. 114, SLA 1951; and  
11 providing for an effective date."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

13 Section 1. Any dog running at large and threatening the  
14 peace, persons, or property in any incorporated political sub-  
15 division of the state, or within ten miles of the boundaries  
16 thereof, may be impounded for a period of ten days. If within  
17 such period the owner of the impounded dog fails to claim the  
18 animal and pay costs of catching and impounding as fixed by such  
19 political subdivision, the dog shall be destroyed or may be sold  
20 to pay such costs.

21 Sec. 2. All incorporated political subdivisions of Alaska  
22 are hereby authorized independently or in agreement with the  
23 State of Alaska, to enforce the provisions of this Act.

24 Sec. 3. Ch. 114, SLA 1951 is hereby repealed.

25 Sec. 4. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its  
26 passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such  
27 approval.
