IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FIRST LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act setting the rate of compensation for employees of the Legislature; and setting an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. RATE OF COMPENSATION. The employees of the Legislature shall be compensated on a daily basis, according to position, in conformity with the following schedule:

Chief Clerk and Secretary of the Senate	\$26.00 to \$35.00
Assistant Chief Clerks and Secretary	22.00
Fiscal Officer	20.00
Duplicating Supervisor	24.00
Duplicating Operators	19.00
Stenographers	18.00 \$19.00
Senior Typists	18.00 19.00
Sergeants-at-Arms	18.00
Clerk Typists	16.00 17.00 ✓
Messengers	16.00
General Clerks	15.00
Doormen	15.00
Cloakroom Attendant	15.00
Janitors	15.00
Chaplains	5.00

Sec. 2. CONDITIONS FOR COMPENSATION. Legislative employees

1 shall be paid within the compensation ranges established herein
2 for particular positions subject to a determination by their
3 immediate supervisor as to aptitude. Employees shall be compensa-
4 ted only for actual days of work as required and reported by their
5 immediate supervisors.

6 Sec. 3. DATE OF ENTITLEMENT. Legislative employees shall
7 be entitled to compensation effective the date of entry upon duty
8 as certified to by their immediate supervisor.

9 Sec. 4. METHOD OF PAYMENT. Compensation for legislative
10 employees shall be paid on warrants drawn on vouchers approved
11 by the Legislative Fiscal Officer.

12 Sec. 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act shall take effect
13 immediately upon its passage and approval or upon its becoming
14 law without such approval.
